When his father, Balon Greyjoy, King of the Iron Islands, rebelled against the throne, Ned Stark defeated him and took Theon as a hostage. Theon became buddy buddy with Ned's son Robb, who became King of the North. In one of his very first stupid decisions, King Robb released Theon and sent him home to persuade his dad Balon to join forces with him.

So this chapter is the story of Theon going home.

Theon has abusive sex with Oatmeal Girl. Theon is not clearly an evil guy at this point, not exactly, but neither is he a very nice one. We meet him on a ship heading home to the Iron Isles. Drowned Men and the faith of the Drowned God. In order to become a priest of the Drowned God, a person has to be drowned and then quickly revived. This is where the drowning part comes in. But the priests are the ones who are drowned, not the God. That's still not a reason to call it a "Drowned" God as opposed to a "Rather Wet Underwater God". Anyway, when someone is drowned and brought back to life, it is said that **what is drowned cannot be killed again and is only stronger**. This is a key part of the faith of the Ironmen. Because they go out on ships, and do a lot of fighting at sea, there is a constant possibility of drowning. But because they believe that drowning will only make them stronger and/or take them to their Drowned God, **their religion causes them not to fear drowning**, and as a result **makes them better fighters at sea**. Here's what they say when they drown someone:

"Open your mouth and drink deep of god's blessing, fill your lungs with water, so you may die and be reborn."

And their favorite line:

"What is dead can never die, but rises harder and stronger"

In other words, once you drown and get revived, you should be invincible. Except if you die.

Theon's dad hates him. Aeron takes Theon to see Balon, Theon's father. You would think Balon would be pleased to see his only living son after ten years of being separated; he isn't. Balon suspects that Theon has become corrupted by the Starks who held him hostage. He immediately takes issue with Theon's velvet and silk clothes, calling him a girl.

Balon even calls Theon a "whore" for buying a gold necklace instead of killing people to get their jewelry from their dead bodies, adding that the "green lands" have made Theon soft and that he has become a Stark.

So this family reunion isn't going as Theon planned. Theon tries to convey Robb Stark's offer of an alliance, but Balon isn't interested in alliances, he wants conquests. Robb offered to "give" Balon a crown, and that offended Balon, who believes that one can only "take" a crown, meaning by conquest.

Balon means to attack the North, Robb's territory. Now that Robb has released Theon and Robb no longer has him as a hostage, Balon can attack Robb. If you think this is the dumbest thing Robb does, you have not yet read the next book, *A Storm of Swords*.

The bottom line:

- 1) Theon seems like a bad guy for the way he treats Oatmeal Girl during sex.
- 2) But it turns out he's actually the nicer one, relatively speaking, compared to his nutty Uncle Aeron who likes to drown people and father Balon who doesn't love his son.
- 3) Balon is not pleased to see his son for the first time in ten years, calls him a pussy.
